





The lessons continue to introduce all the letters and sounds of the Pashto alphabet. They use these letters to build up words and eventually phrases and short sentences up to lesson 55. The first parts of the lessons follow identical formats to the above with pictures to introduce the new letter sounds and writing practice as in the first 4 lessons. At lesson 16 the writing practice includes joined forms of the letters as they are introduced. From lesson 18 a very short reading text is often included. There are review and assessment lessons as above after each new group of letter sounds. In each new lesson there are from 5 to 7 exercises. Lessons 56 – 60 prepare for the next grade by beginning with an appropriate reading text followed by exercises. The exercises vary in format. The following are examples of the different types:
